The Chief Executive Officer is responsible for ensuring continued commitment to packaging safety within the Company and for providing the necessary resources.

Implementation and maintenance of the BRC system is the responsibility of the Health, Safety & Environment Manager who is also the Management Representative.

This policy will be reviewed annually or in the event of significant change within the organisation.
